



Thinking about applying for SURS disability benefits?

Civil Service Employees*

The following is a list of items you will need before applying:

- Two Years of Service Credit
- Physician statement on letterhead or prescription pad with the following information clearly stated:
 - 1. Diagnosis
 - 2. Prognosis
 - 3. Your physician must state that you will need to be off work for at least sixty-one (61) days
- Call and make an appointment with the Service Center at 217-333-2137 or email <u>IHR-Disability@illinois.edu</u> to receive the SURS disability application.

Have you donated to Shared Benefits?

A pool has been established which will provide eligible employees who have exhausted all accumulated sick leave and, if applicable, vacation leave with the opportunity to receive additional leave days when a disability claim is pending before the State Universities Retirement System (SURS) or when experiencing a catastrophic injury or illness, depending on the type of employee.
