



# COVID-19 Employee Guidelines

## Close Contact Quarantine and Infected Isolation

January 11, 2022

**Close Contact:** An individual **not** up to date\* with COVID vaccinations who was within 6 feet of an infected individual for a total time of 15 minutes or more during a 24 hour period prior to the infected person’s isolation, starting from 2 days prior to infected person illness or test collection.

### Close Contact – Exposed to a COVID-19 Positive Individual

Vaccination Status	Required Quarantine Period
<p>Completed primary series (<b>but no booster</b>) of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pfizer or Moderna vaccine more than 5 months ago</li> <li>• J &amp; J series more than 2 months ago</li> <li>• Are unvaccinated or partially vaccinated (1 dose of a two-dose series)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 days at home from date of exposure</li> <li>• Test on day 5</li> <li>• Mask wearing when around others for additional 5 days</li> <li>• If symptoms develop, test and stay at home pending results</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Received a booster shot <b>OR</b></li> <li>• Completed primary 2 dose series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 5 months <b>OR</b></li> <li>• Completed primary series of J &amp; J within the last 2 months <b>OR</b></li> <li>• Tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 90 days and remain asymptomatic</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NO quarantine requirement</li> <li>• Monitor for COVID-19 symptoms</li> <li>• Test at least 5 days after last contact with the positive individual (except those who were positive in last 90 days)</li> </ul>

**Infected Individual:** Person with a positive COVID-19 test result.

<b>Vaccination Status</b>	<b>Required Isolation Period</b>
<b>All individuals, regardless of vaccination</b>  5 day isolation <b>AFTER</b> test result day.	<b>No Symptoms:</b> May leave isolation <b>after</b> day 5 if still symptom free. Must wear a mask around others for next 5 days.  <b>Symptoms Present:</b> May leave isolation after 5 days only if fever free for at least 24 hours w/o medicine and symptoms have gone away or are significantly improved. <b>Loss of taste and smell do not have to be restored.</b> Masks must be worn for the next 5 days.

\*Up to date includes boosters when eligible
