COVID-19 Employee Guidelines Close Contact Quarantine and Infected Isolation

January 11, 2022

Close Contact: An individual <u>not</u> up to date* with COVID vaccinations who was within 6 feet of an infected individual for a total time of 15 minutes or more during a 24 hour period prior to the infected person's isolation, starting from 2 days prior to infected person illness or test collection.

Close Contact - Exposed to a COVID-19 Positive Individual

Completed primary series (but no booster) of:	5 days at home from date of exposure
Pfizer or Moderna vaccine more than 5 months ago	• Test on day 5
J & J series more than 2 months ago	Mask wearing when around others for additional 5 days

(1 dose of a two-dose series)	 If symptoms develop, test and stay at home pending results
Received a booster shot OR	NO quarantine requirement
Completed primary 2 dose series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 5	Monitor for COVID-19 symptoms

Completed primary series of J & J within the last 2 months OR	individual (except those who were positive in last 90 days)
Tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 90 days and remain asymptomatic
